

ACME BASEBALL HALL OF FAME

A. Purpose

The purpose of the ACME Baseball Hall of Fame is to recognize individuals who have distinguished themselves by meritorious service to ACME Baseball.

B. Criteria

- 1 Nominees must have demonstrated good citizenship and meritorious service to ACME Baseball.
- 2 The nominee may be an individual, player, coach, league or district commissioner, Board of Directors, State Commissioner.

C. Selection Process

- 1 Nominations for Hall of Fame consideration shall be in writing and on the official nomination form, which is available at ACME Baseball.com or upon request from the ACME Hall of Fame Director. Nominations may be originated by anyone. Nominations should be forwarded to ACME Baseball Hall of Fame at <http://acmebaseballcongress.org/hall-of-fame/>
- 2 Nominations for the next years Hall Of Fame, must be submitted by December 31 of the previous year.
- 3 The year of induction, Board of Directors will review all nominees and select the candidates to be inducted into the ACME Baseball Hall of Fame. A ballot containing the names of all eligible candidates will be prepared and submitted to the Board of Directors for vote by arrangement in order of points. The top three candidates with the highest points will be selected to ACME HALL OF FAME.
- 4 No more than three nominees shall be inducted into the ACME Baseball Hall of Fame on years of induction.
- 5 Nominations shall be reviewed in February with induction taking place in July at the State ACME Tourney
- 6 The time of induction into the ACME Baseball Hall of Fame shall be set by the State board of Directors, and shall be such as to give proper respect, ceremony and dignity to the Hall of Fame Award.
